News From Saxtead

This Sunday we resumed singing and receiving of Communion wine, and stopped compulsory wearing of masks.

SAXTEAD LADIES COFFEE MORNING will resume meetings in The Old Mill House on Wednesday 13th October, at 10.30.

THE PARISH COUNCIL met on the 9th September where new members Simon Houghton and David Johnson, Paul Johnson and Liz Wale have either been, or are in the process of being co-opted. Disappointingly, Bidwells on behalf of Pembroke College turned down our request for a footpath down the green. The traffic is too fast and constant to allow for the safety of pedestrians, which tend to be school children or the elderly and frail, some on mobility scooters.

Their argument that they are caretakers of ancient wetlands will look hollow should a vulnerable life be lost. Hopefully our application for a footpath on the lethal Saxtead Lodge corner will meet with council approval. Regarding the speed and noise of traffic, in particular of motorbikes, Paul Johnson is going

to gather views from other villages to put a stop to illegal decibel registers.

ALL SAINTS SAXTEAD now has a contactless giving payment terminal installed. The Diocese has included us as part of a pilot scheme.

We have many visitors during the week, and many people no longer carry cash.

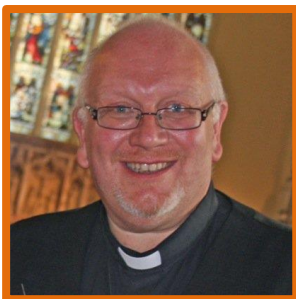
